

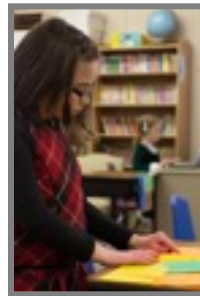

Academic Enrichment

Dubuque Lutheran School is an accredited school offering a Christ-centered enrichment program for homeschooled children in grades K-5. The Homeschool Academy meets Monday through Friday from 12:45-3:30 p.m.

Homeschool Academy students will join DLS students in the classroom and participate in the following subjects which may vary by grade:

- Art
- Spanish
- Choir/Music
- Health
- Religion
- Science
- Social Studies
- P.E. partnered with University of Dubuque

Class openings are limited and full-time students will have priority. The multi-age classes have a maximum class size of 20 including current, full-time students of Dubuque Lutheran School.

Students enrolled in Homeschool Academy are also welcome to participate in recess and lunch from 11:45-12:45. Students may bring their own lunch or purchase hot lunches on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays through the school. Orders for the hot lunch program are placed prior to the start of each month.

Special Events

Any student enrolled in the Homeschool Academy is eligible to participate in the following:

- Spring Musical at Bell Tower – May 2017
- Scholastic Book Fair
- Winter Open House
- Living History Night
- Friends of DLS (PTO) Activities

Tuition and Fees

Tuition for the Homeschool Academy is \$800 per semester (\$160/month) and a supply fee of \$25. For the Fall of 2016, the registration fee has been waived. Special event activities such as field trips may have additional fees.

Tuition is due upon registration. Monthly payments can be arranged if desired.

Questions and Answers

Will enrolling my child in the DLS Homeschool Academy change my child's homeschool status with the district?

No. Your child will be considered a homeschool student participating in an enrichment opportunity through the DLS Homeschool Academy.

How can parents be involved?

DLS Homeschool Academy parents are welcome to volunteer in the classrooms, lunchroom, and other events. Parents are also welcome to attend monthly "Friends" PTO meetings.
