A Note from the DLS Scrip Coordinator

Hello DLS Families!

I recently submitted the 75% Scrip Tuition Credit - families that regularly used Scrip for food, gas and other usual purchases over the past 6 months accrued \$100 - \$200 that was subtracted from their tuition expense. While that appears small compared to the tuition, \$200 and \$400 per year does offset the cost of school supplies, shoes, etc. (Who doesn't like an extra \$100 or so?)

Everything you need is on the school website - if you have already signed up at shopwithscrip.com, you just need to renew the "Scrip Profit Designation Form". If you haven't used Scrip for tuition credit and want to enroll, follow directions for "Scrip Online" and submit the Designation Form just mentioned.

Scrip will continue through the summer - dropping off checks (consider PrestoPay, a secure transfer from your bank account so you can skip the check writing and dropping-off part) and picking up your order can be arranged through the DLS office and/or stopping in during their scheduled and posted summer hours.

Order with payment needs to be in by the Sunday noted and your order will be at DLS the following Thursday. (Our Redeemer families may also receive their order the following Sunday.) Here are the dates:
